



2009 EXTREME HANDS ON A HOUSE RULES

THE CONTEST: This endurance contest pits 20 men and women against each other who must remain standing around the clock with minimum breaks for eating and going to the restroom. The contest is intended to be a fun and festive competition; however, all entrants are reminded that this is a very physical and time-consuming event.

MOST IMPORTANT RULE is simple - take your hand off the house and you lose! Last one standing with a hand on the house gets to take it home. There will always be two official judges on-site. These two officials have the final authority in removing contestants.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN The contest registration period is August 1, 2009 to noon on September 15, 2009. 20 contestants will be drawn or selected from the entries, the 20 contestants will be contacted on the afternoon of Wednesday, September 16th, and their names announced on local radio. AGE Entrants must be 18 years old or older at time of entry.

PHYSICALLY STRENUOUS: The contestants understand that this contest is physically strenuous and a potentially dangerous activity.

PRE CONTEST MEETING: Contestants are required to attend a pre-contest meeting at 5:00 p.m. Friday, September 19th. Failure to attend the pre-contest meeting and check in at 5:00 p.m. at the "Diner" will result in disqualification.

CONTEST SPONSORS: Avalon Custom Homes, W.T. Harris Co., and Coldwell Banker, Mark Campbell & Associates are the contest officials. and reserve the right, for any and all portions of this promotion; to alter the number of contestants participating in an event if any qualified contestant scheduled to take part in that event does not arrive or subsequently decides not to participate. Any such qualified contestant scheduled to take part in an event that does not arrive at the required time or subsequently decides not to participate will be automatically disqualified from participating further in the promotion. Judges retain the right to dismiss any contestant who, in the discretion of the judges, becomes problematic, hostile, displays inappropriate behavior, or violates any rule or instruction of the contest. All decisions of the judges will be final.

CONTEST LOCATION: The contest will take place Friday, Saturday, and Sunday during the Brownwood Reunion Celebration. The location of the contest is directly across the street from the Adams Street Community Center on the corner of Carnegie and Adams Street.

TYPICAL RULES: Contestants must place one hand on the house and their hand must remain in constant contact with the house except during specified break periods or during new competition periods. No sitting, leaning or squatting will be permitted at any time. No chairs will be allowed. Nor artificial devices such as stools, leg props, canes, crutches, etc., will be allowed.

THE PRIZES: The first place winner will win the house and will be responsible for having it moved to their home. Second place prizes will be awarded.

CONTEST OFFICIALS: Coldwell Banker, Mark Campbell & Associates, Avalon Homes, & WT Harris are the contest officials.

FOOD DRIVE RULES: Due to the success of the 2008 FOOD DRIVE, again this year, in conjunction with the HANDS ON A HOUSE COMPETITION we are pleased to announce another FOOD DRIVE. Contestants are asked to bring to the COMPETITION non-perishable food items. Additionally, spectators and visitors of the reunion will be asked to make donations of food on behalf of one of the competitors. The competitor with the most food donated in his or her name will be rewarded an additional break or breaks during the competition. All food will be given to two local charities: Doers Ministries and the Food Pantry at Saint John's Episcopal Church.

EXTREME 2009 RULES: This year's elimination rounds will begin as early as Saturday morning. These elimination rounds may include participating in the Reunion parade, food drive competitions, a blind folded round, a costume contest, a Simon says contest, a waiters contest, and or other physical and mental challenges.
